November Volunteer of the Month: Camrie Schwartz

For the 2012 State Fall Games, Camrie Schwartz took on the vital role of bocce volunteer coordinator. As anyone that has been to the State Fall Games in the past few years can tell you, bocce is a huge venue that starts that Friday afternoon and ends on Sunday, while most venues at the Fall Games take place in one day. There was a total of 22 traditional and unified bocce courts with each court using two to three volunteers – that is a total of 44 to 66 volunteers - and it was Camrie who managed each court and each volunteer. Camrie was out there all weekend – as long as the SOGA staff – with her cute pink baseball cap, leading volunteers and making sure that bocce ran smoothly. She was a crucial part of the bocce team and kept both fields efficient. Sometimes the volunteer coordinators role is downplayed but that role, especially in a venue as big as bocce, is important and no one – not staff, venue directors, etc – could run a venue without them, and everyone at SOGA is truly grateful to Camrie for stepping into the role and being a fantastic first time volunteer coordinator.


