

## UNIFIED CHAMPION SCHOOLS



At its core, the Unified Champion Schools strategy is not just about ncluding students with disabilities, but unifying all students; moving from adult-led programming to student-led mobilization and action; while transitioning from sports as recreation to sports as a catalyst for social inclusion and change.





The Special Olympics Unified Champion Schools program is aimed at promoting social inclusion through intentionally planned and implemented activities affecting systems-wide change. With sports as the foundation, the three component model offers a unique combination of effective activities that equip young people with tools and training to create sports, classroom and school climates of acceptance. These are school climates where students with disabilities feel welcome and are routinely included in, and feel a part of all activities, opportunities and functions.

In 2022, Special Olympics Georgia added 35 new schools to the Unified Champion Schools program. As of today, the state of Georgia has 84 grade level schools, 23 Young Athletes programs, and 14 S.O. Colleges involved. We look forward to the year to come with Unified Champion Schools and hope everyone continues to join us in the Inclusion Revolution!

The Law Enforcement Torch Run (LETR) had another impactful year for the athletes.

They raised \$1,093,378 throughout their various fundraising events and initiatives.

Although sports are the center of our mission, we step off the field to raise funds and awareness for our athletes and individuals with intellectual disabilities so they can benefit from all that SOGA has to offer. Some of our 2022 events included:

The 13th annual Polar Plunge was held at Acworth Beach on February 19th. We had 341 Plungers come out and raise money to jump into the freezing lake. With the help of all our supports for this event we were able to raise \$217,382.





Our 17th annual Duck Pluck was such a great turn out for 2022! We were able to give away \$1500 in gift cards and a brand new Dell Laptop to 6 of our contributors. Our goal of 11,000 ducks were sold and our amazing supporters helped us raise \$89,176.

The <u>Bob Busse Golf Classic</u> was held at The Atlanta Country Club on November 7th. Thanks to the generosity of our sponsors and golfers this event raised \$114,791, which surpassed our goal. 128 golfers from 32 different teams showed up to compete in this 27th annual event to help raise money for our athletes.







We are always thankful for Marlow's
