Special K's

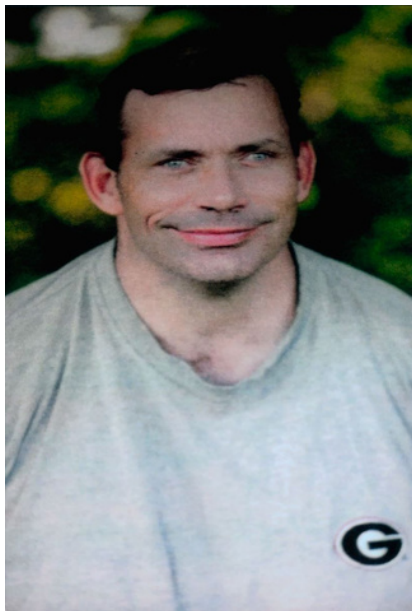

Our goal is to help bring persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities into the larger society under conditions whereby they are accepted, respected, and given the chance to become useful and productive citizens. 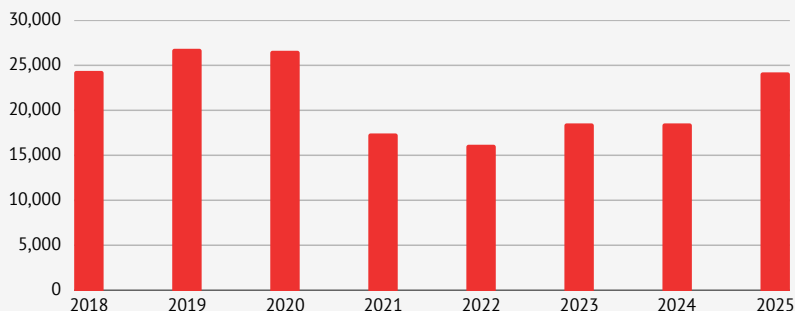

SPECIAL OLYMPICS UNIFIED SPORTS®

Special Olympics Unified Sports® is an initiative that combines approximately equal numbers of Special Olympics athletes and athletes without intellectual and developmental disabilities (called Partners) on sports teams for training and competition. Age and ability matching of athletes and Partners is defined on a sport-by-sport basis.



UNIFIED SPORTS® – Introduced in 1988, Unified Sports furthers Special Olympics Georgia's commitment to foster inclusion into school and community sports programs. Unified Sports programs bring together on the same team, athletes with and without intellectual and developmental disabilities.

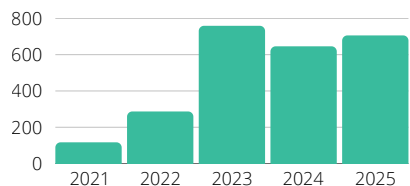
These teams train and compete with other Unified Sports teams in 29 sports – alpine skiing/snowboarding, athletics, artistic gymnastics, badminton, basketball, bocce, bowling, cheerleading, cycling, dance, equestrian, figure/speed ice skating, flag football, floor hockey, golf, kayaking, pickleball, powerlifting, rhythmic gymnastics, sailing, soccer, softball, roller skating, swimming, table tennis, tennis and volleyball. Unified Sports furthers Special Olympics Georgia's commitment to foster inclusion into school and community sports programs.

HEALTHY ATHLETES & MEDFESTS IN 2025

The Special Olympics Healthy Athletes program continued to grow in 2025, providing essential health screenings and education to athletes across six disciplines, Fit Feet, FUNfitness, Healthy Hearing, Opening Eyes, Special Smiles, Strong Minds. By creating a fun, welcoming healthcare environment, the program not only addresses immediate health needs but also advances more inclusive healthcare systems for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

At State Games, 706 athletes received screenings, while more than 400 participated in annual MedFests, receiving free medical exams that ensure eligibility to compete, along with opportunities to connect through games and activities. Over 60 pairs of glasses, 230 fluoride treatments, and 70 emotional wellness tools were given out to athletes. This year also marked the addition of two new Clinical Directors, Dr. Zakers (Strong Minds) and Dr. Elliott (FUNfitness), strengthening program leadership. FUNfitness made its debut at Battle of the Bats, promoting flexibility, balance, strength, and endurance.

Special Olympics Georgia extends its sincere thanks to more than 300 health professional volunteers and dedicated medical providers whose support makes this work possible and helps athletes continue to train and compete.

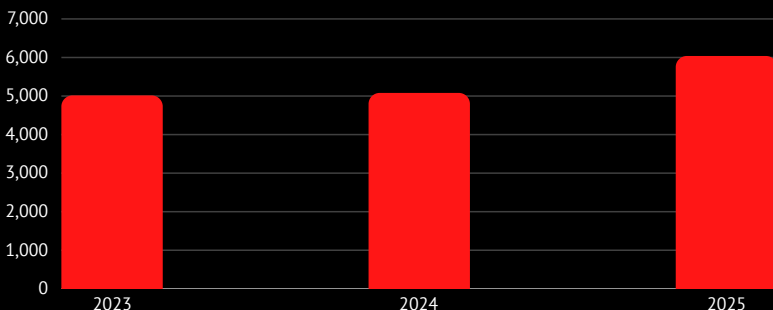

Although sports are the center of our mission, we step off the field to raise funds and awareness for our athletes and individuals with intellectual disabilities so they can benefit from all that SOGA has to offer. Some of our 2025 events included:

The 18th annual Polar Plunge was held at Acworth Beach on February 21st. We had 289 Plungers come out and raise money to jump into the freezing lake. With the help of all our supporters for this event, we raised \$234,973.



Our 19th Annual Duck Pluck was held September 17th, 2025. We awarded 1st-5th place prizes to our generous contributors, and thanks to our amazing supporters, 7,293 ducks were adopted, helping us raise \$101,157.37 to support our athletes.

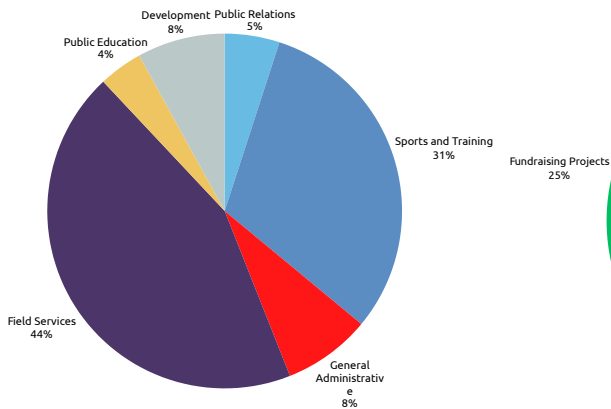

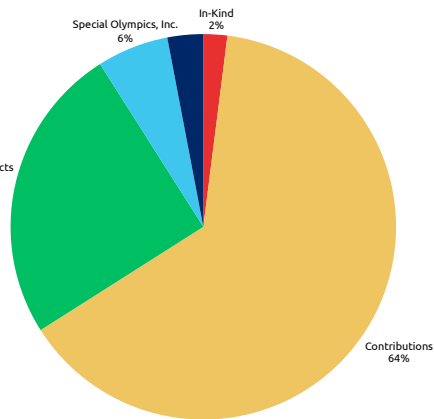
