Thank you for the continued support of the 26,620 registered athletes of Special Olympics Georgia (SOGA). We wish you continued good health this year as the pandemic is still among us. Special Olympics Georgia continues to benefit the lives of children and adults with intellectual disabilities. We hope you've been following us on social media as we doubled our friends and followers in 2020, and we post daily to stay connected to you and the athletes.

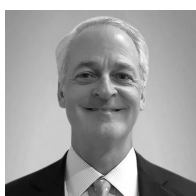
Although 2020 was a difficult year for us all, we still made the most of it when recognizing our 50th anniversary as an organization. We were able to host the 2020 State Indoor Winter Games in mid January, which was a major success. A new healthy athletes discipline called Health Promotion was added to those games. We also had a participation growth of 8.6% and our number of health screenings of the athletes increased from 148 to 235 at the games.

SOGA was not able to have the athletes participate in all of the 2020 competitions, however, we were involved in their lives during quarantine virtually. We posted on our website and social media some ways to keep our athletes going. Some of the activities we set up for our athletes were: virtual bingo, a dance party, virtual workouts, a costume contest and basketball drills given by the Atlanta Hawks. We also created challenges for the athletes, such as our paint challenge, healthy athletes challenge by eating fruits and vegetables, a pumpkin carving contest, and indoor scavenger hunt. SOGA hosted a walk week to give athletes a reason to get up and get outside, free online mindfulness sessions for practicing meditation and managing stress, and taught them how to make stress balls. We have missed the athletes just as much as they've missed us, and they have sent us videos sharing how they spent their time during quarantine and what they miss most about SOGA. "I have missed all my friends and playing Special Olympics sports since the covid crisis began earlier this year...I have found ways to have fun at home" – Will from Forsyth County.

We are still taking precautions to keep all athletes, coaches, and volunteers safe, and are grateful to be able to continue the mission of helping Special Olympics Athletes share their gifts & capabilities with the community. Thank you for the support and we look forward to working with you, all of the coaches, volunteers, sponsors, law enforcement and more importantly the Special Olympics Georgia athletes in 2021.

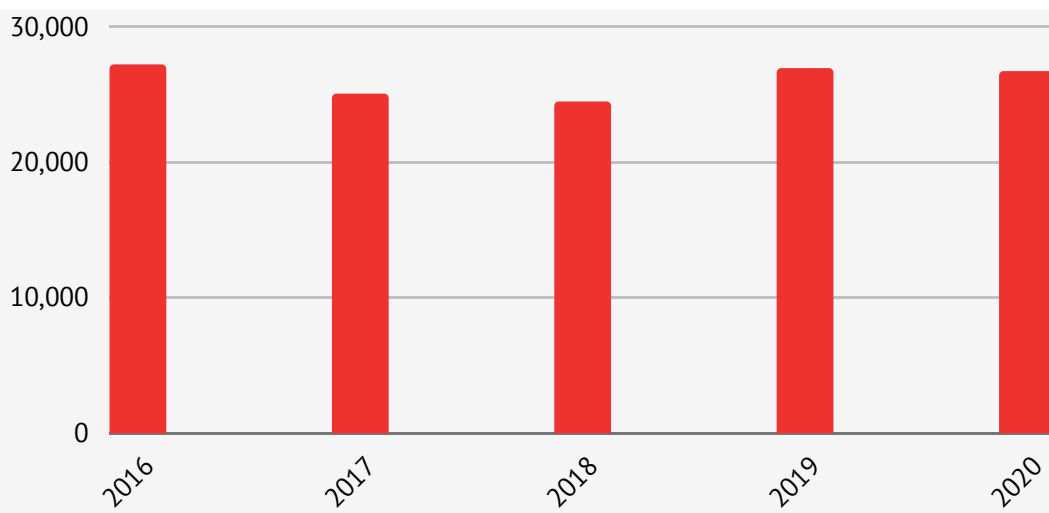

At its core, the Unified Champion Schools strategy is not just about including students with disabilities, but unifying all students; moving from adult-led programming to student-led mobilization and action; and transitioning from sports as recreation to sports as a catalyst for social inclusion and change.

The Special Olympics Unified Champion Schools program is aimed at promoting social inclusion through intentionally planned and implemented activities affecting systems-wide change. With sports as the foundation, the three component model offers a unique combination of effective activities that equip young people with tools and training to create sports, classroom and school climates of acceptance. These are school climates where students with disabilities feel welcome and are routinely included in, and feel a part of, all activities, opportunities and functions.

In 2020, Special Olympics Georgia added 12 new schools to the Unified Champion Schools Program. As of today, the state of Georgia has 30 grade level schools, 12 Young Athlete's programs, and 13 Colleges involved. We look forward to the years to come with Unified Champion Schools and hope everyone joins us in the Inclusion Revolution.

HEALTHY ATHLETES INITIATIVES

Healthcare professionals volunteer their time to provide health screenings and education to athletes in 5 different disciplines. The Healthy Athletes Program offers a fun and welcoming healthcare environment for athletes, while working to improve healthcare policies and programs for individuals with intellectual disabilities.

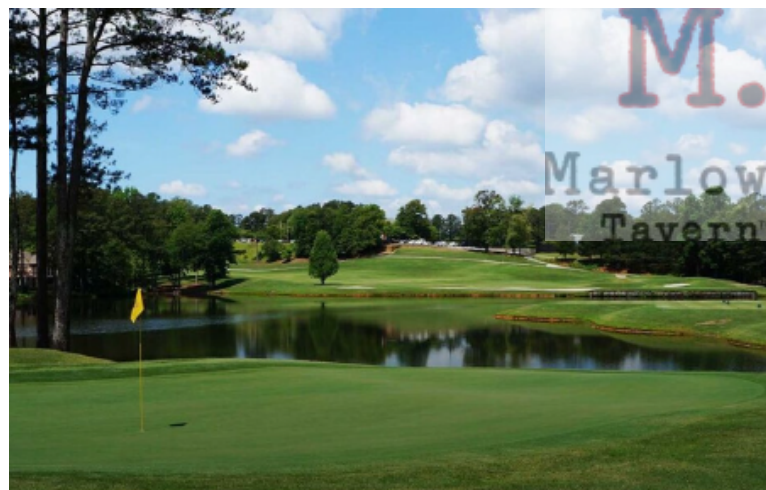

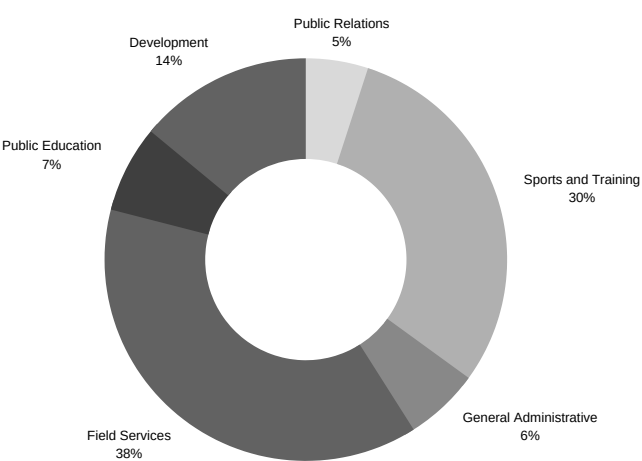

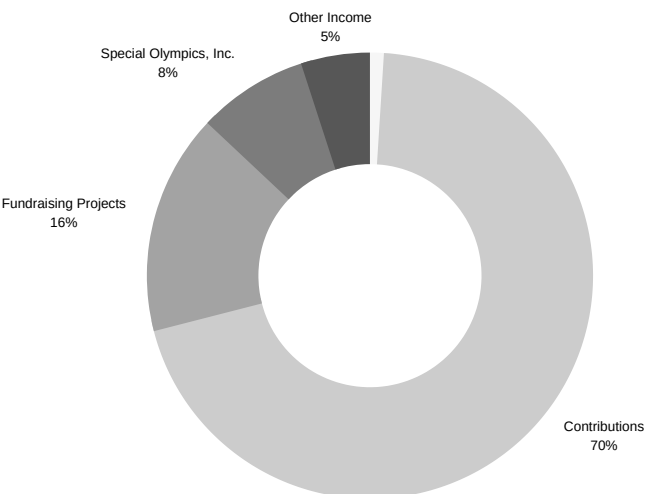
